The Catholic University of Eastern Africa (CUEA) is a non-profit making private institution of higher learning founded in 1984.

FACULTIES

There are five faculties namely, Theology, Science, Commerce, Education, Arts and Social Sciences, plus a Centre for Social Justice and Ethics, and a Research Department. The Bachelor of Laws and Master of Business Administration are the latest programmes to be launched.

STRATEGIC PLAN

The University launched a "Strategic Development Plan 2002-2011". A major undertaking of the Strategic Plan is to establish research links with other institutions of higher learning and research centres all over the world. In order to achieve this, an Academic Linkages Office was established in 2004 to back up the University's Research Department. Its main function is to coordinate research and other forms of academic linkages.

One of the priority areas of the University's research interest is empowerment of disadvantaged individuals and communities. One of the strategic objectives of this plan is to invite interested individuals and institutions to partner with The Catholic University of Eastern Africa to realise this undertaking.
